AT THE NOVEMBER 2024 MEETING 19th District Chicago Police Department, Community Relations – Sgt. Angelo

Co-President Sam Samatas gave the Membership a bio of presenter Sgt. Angelo. He has been on the Police Force since 2006. Was a detective from 2017-2019 and has been a Sergeant since 2019. He has a B.S. in Criminology from Loyola University and a Masters in Threat and Response Management from the University of Chicago.

Sgt Angelo started out with some crime definitions, statistics and trends.

19th District Year-to-Date:

Robberies— taking or attempting to take anything of value from a person by force or threat of force. 359 up 1%

Burglaries- unlawful entry of a structure to commit a felony or theft. 606 up 26%

Aggravated Battery- intentional causing or attempt to cause serious bodily harm or threat of serious bodily injury or death. Includes aggravated assault, aggravated battery and attempted murder. 229 up 27%

Criminal Sexual Assault- Rape and includes when someone either touches another person in a sexual

manner without consent or makes another person touch them in a sexual manner without consent. 111 up 6%

Theft- unlawful taking or attempted taking of property or articles without the use of force, violence or fraud. 1,478 down 7%

Motor Vehicle Theft- unlawful taking or attempt to take a motor vehicle. 818 down 21%

Murder- 4 no change

Shooting Incident- 21 up 17%

Sgt. Angelo indicated that arrests in the robbery and burglary areas have been good. Nevertheless, these crimes are spiking city-wide. He noted that the majority of these crimes are done by "spur groups" that during a night will hit several businesses with smash and grab burglaries and if the opportunity arises, will rob individuals walking on the street. The Sergeant noted that though the numbers in these categories are increasing, it is not more individuals committing the crimes, but the spur groups committing a rash of multiple crimes. He also noted that compared to gangs of the past they are smaller in number, no longer centralized, do not recognize former gang boundaries and are sometimes from out-of-state like from Milwaukee.

Battling crime. The Sergeant told how increased technology can help increase the arrest rate. License plate readers and individual home front door ring cameras or security cameras are used. Contact the 19th District to integrate your security system into the CPD program. Sgt. Angelo noted that upper management CPD officers attend seminars held by the FBI or other law agencies and share information with other police departments

Lt. Lohse then took the podium. He addressed how CPD is analyzing crime data statistics in order to deploy officers to the higher crime areas and at times that crimes are more likely to occur. CPD is offering overtime pay to officers to entice them to work at night when crime is naturally higher instead of the day when crime is lower. The Lieutenant described a recent burglary arrest where a business was burglarized, a security video from inside the store was blast emailed to officers on duty and the Lieutenant was in the area and able to identify the perpetrators on the street and make an arrest. He also described a "burglary mission" group that works from 2AM-7AM and is supported by the CPD helicopter.




